Regeneration of derelict sites and Grade II listed buildings within the World Heritage Site, including historic warehouses and a former police bridewell, into a vibrant mixed-use neighbourhood. Phase 1 created 32,000 sq.ft of new offices, commercial units, residential “loft” warehouse conversions, apartments, duplexes and penthouses, all surrounding three new landscaped courtyards. Phase 2 included 77 apartments and underground parking.

At its heart is Campbell Square, a new open space designed by BCA Landscape with specially commissioned public art “The Seed”. Phase 1 – The Beetham Organization Space Developments UK Project value £27M. Phase 1 created 32,000 sq.ft of new offices, commercial units, residential “loft” warehouse conversions, apartments, duplexes and penthouses, all surrounding three new landscaped courtyards.

Phase 2 included 77 apartments and underground parking.
